CTSC 2019 | Conference Theme

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Identifying the need for an industry shift in approach to the benefits of an integrated technical security program is complex when there is resistance to change by industry players and practitioners. The traditional approach has relied on the independent application of Technical Surveillance Countermeasures (TSCM), Physical Security concepts, and Cyber Security on an as needed basis, often without a unified focus. The need to apply a balanced approach and coordinated effort, decidedly outside the comfort zone of many technical operators, is fast becoming an essential best practice. The uncoordinated patchwork of incremental and ad hoc measures is inadequate in today's complex and fluid environment – the inevitable gaps and weaknesses will be found and exploited by a determined and resourceful attacker. The ability of technical security professionals to go beyond the narrow scope of work, and work with other industry experts in a coherent and systematic defensive effort will become an essential methodology. The technical security threat model has continued to change in complexity, during the past decade, to a more fluid and dynamic Moving Target Threat Model, leading us to the CTSC 2019 focus and theme:
